Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Cayuga, Vermillion County, Indiana, that:-

Whereas, the petition of John L. Peters and others has been filed in the office of the Auditor of said county on February 3, 1913, which petition asks and requests that a highway in Eugene Township connecting the Higgins Free Gravel Road with the Cayuga and State Line Road, be laid out, established and improved under what is known as the Three Mile Gravel Road law,
