was on the *7th* day of *Jan.*, 191*3*, appointed by the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County, Indiana, ENGINEER for the location of the *Gas Board* et al., Gravel Road under "An Act" concerning highways, approved March 8th, 1905.

Now, if the said *John A. Boor* shall well and faithfully discharge the duties of his said trust as such Engineer for the location of such highway according to law, then the above obligation to be null and void; else to remain in full force and effect in law.
