

CONTRACTOR'S BOND FOR CONSTRUCTION.

(NOTE.—See Acts 1907, page 582, Section 5. The bond must be signed by a responsible Bonding or Surety Company, or by at least two resident freeholders of the State of Indiana, whose financial responsibility has been investigated and is certified either by the Auditor or the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County in which such Sureties reside, even though they reside in Vermillion County. Any bond with freehold Sureties without such certificate will not be considered. This certificate is not necessary where a responsible Bonding or Surety Company is the Surety.)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, the undersigned Paul Thomas of Vermillion County, in the State of Indiana, as Principal and Daniel M. Thomas and Francis N. Austin, Milton F. Lottier, and John W. Redman residents and freeholders of Vermillion County, in the State of Indiana, as Sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Indiana, in the penal sum of Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, and our joint and several heirs, executors, administrators and assigns firmly by these presents, this Seventh day of April 1918.

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATIONS ARE SUCH, That, whereas, The Board of Commissioners of the County of Vermillion, in the State of Indiana, are about to let a contract for the building & construction of a gravel road in Eugene Township in Vermillion County, State of Indiana, known as the Carter Free gravel road, as petitioned for by Harry A. Carter

AND WHEREAS, the above named Paul Thomas has filed a bid herewith for said work with the Auditor of the County of Vermillion.

NOW, therefore if the said Board of Commissioners shall award said Paul Thomas a contract for said work and improvement or any portion thereof, and the said Paul Thomas shall promptly enter into a contract for said work with the the said Board of
