Commencing in the center of the Range Line and Foncarnon Road at a point which is Forty (40) rods. more or less, West from the Southeast corner of Section Six (6) in Township Fifteen (15) North, of Range Nine (9) West, thense North. following the present road, One Half (1-2) mile, more or less, thence West One Eighth (1-8) mile, more or less, to its intersection with the "Ingram and Brick Church" Road, said road being Five Eighths (5-8) miles in length, more or less, and situated wholly within Helt Township, Vermillion County, Indiana, and is connected at either end with a free gravel road of said County. y our petitioners further ask tha' on the presenting of this petition that your Honorable body will appoint a competent civil engineer and two viewers, each of whom shall be a responsible freeholder and voter of said County, and not a resident of, nor taxpayer, nor the owner of taxable property in said Township, to make all needful surveys of said road. determining whether such improvements shall be of public utility as these petitioners think it is, the width of such highway, not less than Thirty-six (36) nor more than Forty (40) feet, the character of the improvements, including grading, draining, paving, together with complete plans and specifications of said improvements, and all other requirements therein, and estimate the cost of each improvement to be made and after all things are found to be regular and in conformity to law, with reference to the above requirements, that said highway will be ordered made without submitting Meditor, Vermillion County, India
