

And the Board being further advised finds that said report was on file and remained on file with the Auditor of said County for more than ten days, open to the inspection of every person interested therein, and his agents and attorneys, and that the said viewers have inquired into and made examination for the purpose of assessing damages that might be justly due to any infant, idiot or person of unsound mind and to any person or corporation making a written claim thereof on account of the appropriation of or injury to his property by the laying out and establishing of said highway and the improvement of said highway described in said report; and after said ten days, and at this session of this Board, to-wit: the 7th day of April, 1913, said viewers have made and filed their supplemental report in writing, showing the fact to be and the Board finds that there were no damages sustained or claims made therefor by any infant, idiot or person of unsound mind, and that no corporation or other party made any written claim for damages; said supplemental report being in full in accordance with the law.

And which supplemental Report was filed in the County Auditor's office on the 7th day of April 1913, and which Supplemental Report is in the words and figures following, to-wit:
