

**STATEMENT TO BE A PART OF ALL BIDS FOR

The bidder declares and represents as an inducement to the acceptance of the proposal hereto attached that the price set forth herein is fair and just and usual; that he has not offered to nor received from any person, firm, board, commission, trustee or corporation since October 1, 1909, a less price for the (articles, materials or work,) embraced in this bid than that stated herein, when the bid has been for like amounts, and the difference in transportation charges taken into account, except.....

that if this bidder shall offer to or receive from any person, firm, board, commission, trustee or corporation, during the continuance of the contract sought hereunder, a less price than that herein stated, excepting only such as shall be caused by difference in amounts and transportation charges as above mentioned, and by usual and recorded market changes, he consents that the difference shall be deducted from any sum due to him under said contract, or, if there be none, that said difference may be recovered from him by appropriate action, as a liquidated indebtedness; and it is hereby agreed by this bidder that this stipulation shall be inserted in and be a part of any contract that may be entered into upon this bid; and this bidder further represents and agrees that he will not, directly or indirectly, withdraw this bid from the office in which it is filed, and that the same shall, in the manner and form in which it is made, become and remain a part of the public documents in said office.
