

**CONTRACTOR'S BOND FOR CONSTRUCTION.**

(NOTE.—See Acts 1907, page 582, Section 5. The bond must be signed by a responsible Bonding or Surety Company, or by at least two resident freeholders of the State of Indiana, whose financial responsibility has been investigated and is certified either by the Auditor or the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County in which such Sureties reside, even though they reside in \_\_\_\_\_ County. Any bond with freehold Sureties without such certificate will not be considered. This certificate is not necessary where a responsible Bonding or Surety Company is the Surety.)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, the undersigned, George R. Chapman of Terre Haute County, in the State of Indiana, as Principal and The Fidelity Guaranty and Surety Company and \_\_\_\_\_ residents and freeholders of \_\_\_\_\_ County, in the State of Indiana, as Sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Indiana, in the penal sum of Forty - seven Thousand Six Hundred Dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, and our joint and several heirs, executors, administrators and assigns firmly by these presents, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1912.

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATIONS ARE SUCH, That, whereas, The Board of Commissioners of the County of Terre Haute, in the State of Indiana, are about to let a contract for the building & the construction of the C. & O. Coal and Gravel Road including the track work in Terre Haute Township, Terre Haute County, Indiana.

AND WHEREAS, the above named George R. Chapman has filed a bid herewith for said work with the Auditor of the County of Terre Haute.

NOW, therefore if the said Board of Commissioners shall award said George R. Chapman a contract for said work and improvement or any portion thereof, and the said George R. Chapman shall promptly enter into a contract for said work with the the said Board of
