

APPOINTMENT OF VIEWERS.

And the Board appoints J. A. Booe
whom the Board finds to be a competent Civil Engineer, as En-
gineer, and Grant Overpeck
and Ed Randolph
as Viewers, each of whom the Board finds to be a responsible
freeholder and voter of Vermillion County and not a resident of,
nor the owner of taxable property in Clinton
Township, in said County.

And the Auditor is hereby ordered and directed to give
notice to said Civil Engineer and said Viewers of their appoint-
ment, also a certified copy of said petition; that said Civil En-
gineer and Viewers are ordered to meet at ~~the County Auditor's~~
~~office at Newport,~~ Indiana, on the 16 th day of July
1913, and each subscribe an oath to faith-
fully and impartially discharge his duties. And such engineer
shall execute and file with the Auditor his bond payable to the
State of Indiana in the penal sum of five thousand dollars, con-
ditioned as required by law.

And they shall proceed without delay to view and make all
needful surveys of the road petitioned for and determine—

(a) Whether any proposed highway or part of highway de-
scribed in petition will be of public utility.

(b) Whether as to said proposed highway or any part
thereof it will be of public utility to grade, drain and pave the
same as therein prayed.

(c) The width of the highway to be improved.

(d) The character of the improvement including grading,
draining and paving to be made of the highway mentioned in the
petition, which they find will be of public utility, together with
complete plans and specifications of such improvement and of all
bridges, culverts and waterways required therein.

(e) The estimated cost of the improvement to be made.

And said Civil Engineer and Viewers shall file in the office
of the Auditor of said County on or before August 4th
1913, their report in writing, signed by each of them, setting
forth their determination in said matter, including an accurate
description of said highway to be improved as above set forth
and which they are to determine, together with their recom-
mendations as to the paving materials to be used, and complete
plans and specifications for such improvement to be made, and
the estimated cost of such improvement, together with an ac-
