

REPORT.

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County, Indiana:

The Undersigned, Herbert Sawyer and John H. Hughes viewers, and J. A. Bore engineer, heretofore appointed in the above named cause, beg leave to submit the following report, to-wit:

That they met at the time and place named in the order issued in the above entitled cause, and after being duly sworn as provided by law to act as such viewers and engineer, and said J. A. Bore having filed his bond as such engineer, in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, which bond was approved by the Auditor, they proceeded to view and locate said proposed gravel road in accordance with the order of the Commissioners.

And they find that said road will be of public utility, and that the improvement of said road, by grading, draining and graveling said road as hereinafter set forth, will be of public utility, and that the following is description of the commencement, route and terminus of the proposed road, a description of the work proposed, the grade, drains, culverts, kind of bridges and improvements and quality and depth of gravel to be used, and also an estimate of the cost of construction, including the cost of culverts, drainage and all things necessary for the completion of the road.

They also file herewith, and marked Exhibit "A," a profile showing the grade of said work.

DESCRIPTION OF ROUTE.

Beginning in the center of the H.Q Porter free gravel road at the south east corner of Section (32) Township (18) north, of range (9) west and running thence east on the Congressional township line between townships (17) and (18) north, of range nine west to the line dividing ~~the~~ Vermillion County from Parke County and Fountain County. Total length eight thousand five hundred feet.
