The Undersigned, John A Hughes and

Silas V Morgan , viewers, and J.A.Booe engineer, heretofore appointed in the above named cause, beg leave to submit the following report, to-wit:

And they find that said road will be of public utility, and that the improvement of said road, by grading, draining and graveling said road as hereinafter set forth, will be of public utility, and that the following is description of the commencement, route and terminus of the proposed road, a description of the work proposed, the grade, drains, culverts, kind of bridges and improvements and quality and depth of gravel to be used, and also an estimate of the cost of construction, including the cost of culverts, drainage and all things necessary for the completion of the road.

They also file herewith, and marked Exhibit "A," a profile showing the grade of said work.

DESCRIPTION OF ROUTE.

1st, Beginning at the north west corner of section one Township fourteen north, of range ten west, on the line dividing Clinton and Helt Townships, and running thence east on and along said Township line 12000 feet, to where said township line road intersects with the Clinton and Center Church free gravel road.

2nd Beginning at the north west corner of section two
Township fourteen north, of range ten west, on the line dividing
Clinton and Helt townships, and run thence west on and along said line
7650 feet to where said road diverges from said township line into
said Helt Township.
