

CONTRACTOR'S BOND FOR CONSTRUCTION.

(NOTE.—See Acts 1907, page 582, Section 5. The bond must be signed by a responsible Bonding or Surety Company, or by at least two resident freeholders of the State of Indiana, whose financial responsibility has been investigated and is certified either by the Auditor or the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County in which such Sureties reside, even though they reside in Vermillion County. Any bond with freehold Sureties without such certificate will not be considered. This certificate is not necessary where a responsible Bonding or Surety Company is the Surety.)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, the undersigned Dan M Thomas of Vermillion County, in the State of Indiana, as Principal, and The Title Guaranty & Surety Company and of Scranton Pennsylvania and
